

**Exodus 33:1 HCSB** The LORD spoke to Moses: "Go, leave here, you and the people you brought up from the land of Egypt, to the land I promised to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, saying: I will give it to your offspring.

<sup>1</sup>**Go, leave here.** The two imperatives underscore the immediacy of the demand: "go, go up," meaning "get going up" or "be on your way."

**The land I promised.** Or "the land which I swore."

**The people you brought.** Cp Exodus 32:7. Isn't it interesting and funny that when the people are bad they're "Moses" people? It's like parents with bad children.

**To your offspring.** *Heb* "seed." Cp Genesis 12:7; Exodus 32:13
